Cork University Hospital requires a haematology Consultant doctor.

Description:

Cork University Hospital is the largest university teaching hospital in Ireland and the only Level 1 Trauma centre in the country due to the presence of over 40 different medical and surgical specialties on the campus. CUH is the tertiary referral centre for the HSE Southern area, and the supra regional area of Limerick, Clare, Tipperary, Waterford and Kilkenny. CUH therefore acts as a regional centre for secondary and tertiary care for the catchment population of 550,000 served by the HSE Southern area and a supra-regional centre for a total a population of 1.1 million.

In 2016 CUH had 63,444 ED presentations, 209,947 out-patient attendances 45,493 inpatient discharges and 80,938 day cases.

The maternity services had 7638 births and 90,453 outpatient attendances.

CUH has 800 beds and this will increase further to 1,000 beds on completion of the transfer of additional services to the CUH campus. CUH currently employs 3,269 (WTE) staff of multiple professions and is the primary teaching hospital for the Faculty of Health and Science in University College Cork.

Benefits:

- Initial contract of 6 months- 1 year.
- Approximate net monthly salary of **5000-6000€ net/month (0.8 Working Time per week)** after tax and pension deductions for Consultant positions. Typical long term Consultants in Ireland are earning in excess of 10.000€ net/month (approximately 200.000€ gross/year).

- Up to 3000€ for educational funding for Consultants.

Requirements and Qualifications:

1. Should be a **Specialist in haematology inside the European Union**. Will need to get registered with the Irish Medical Council on the Specialist Registrar but we can help you with that if not yet registered. Please take into account that the process can take up to 3 months in total.
2. Should have an interest in **coagulation**. CUH has the biggest haemophilia centre in Ireland.
3. Have a very good command of written and spoken English.
4. Good motivation to go to Ireland to work as a doctor as from July-August 2019.
